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The submission of a paper implies the author's assurance that it has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. All papers will be refereed, and the decision to publish a paper rests solely with the editors.

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All papers should include a brief abstract. The abstract should involve as little mathematical notation as possible and have no displayed formulas since, upon acceptance of the paper, the abstract will be published on the IJM website.

The paper should also include the 1991 Mathematics Subject Classification number(s). A list of classification numbers can be found in the December issue of Mathematical Reviews.
