This volume of the Rocky Mountain Mathematics Journal is dedicated to Paul Waltman on the occasion of his sixtieth birthday. The papers in this volume were presented at the 20th Midwest ODE Meeting, celebrating Professor Waltman's birthday, held at the University of Iowa, December 5 and 6, 1991. Almost all of these focus on areas of mathematics to which Paul Waltman has contributed.
