After that, the President reported the fifth meeting of the Japan Academy Public Lectures was opened to the public at Kyoto Kaikan at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 25, with Dr. Takeo HIRAOKA, M. J. A., and Dr. Takeyoshi KAWASHIMA, M. J. A., as speakers, whose respective subjects were:

"Chinese characters and their cultural background"

"Religion, state and law—from a jurist's point of view".

Then, it was submitted to elect Prof. Ronald Philip Dore and Sir George Porter to the Honorary Membership of the Academy on the recommendation of Sections I and II, respectively. This was approved unanimously.

Finally, the election of Secretary-General took place to succeed Dr. Kenjiro Kimura; Dr. Yoshitaro Wakimura was elected.

The Meeting adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
