

Information for authors

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The Illinois Journal of Mathematics endeavors to publish original research articles of high quality in all areas of mathematics. Manuscripts, in duplicate, should be sent to the Illinois Journal of Mathematics, University of Illinois, 1409 West Green St., Urbana, Illinois 61801, USA, or directly to one of the editors listed on the inside front cover. The cover letter should include the name, address, and e-mail address (if available) of the author to whom correspondence should be sent.

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If possible, papers should be typeset in one of the standard flavors of $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$. We prefer papers prepared in $\text{L}_{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ or $\text{L}_{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}2_{\text{e}}$, but we can also handle other versions of $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$. After a paper has been accepted, the author will be contacted with instructions on submitting electronic files. However, for the initial submission of a paper, and for the submission of any revised versions, hard copies are required.

All papers should include a brief abstract. The abstract should involve as little mathematical notation as possible and have no displayed formulas since, upon acceptance of the paper, the abstract will be published on the IJM website.

The paper should also include the 1991 Mathematics Subject Classification number(s). A list of classification numbers can be found in the December issue of Mathematical Reviews.
